

## UK Gambling Commission signs MoU with the Swedish Gambling Authority

Spelinspektionen (the Swedish Gambling Authority, SGA) and the UK Gambling Commission have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) which will enhance and build cooperation between the two organisations.

The aim of the MoU is to support closer working between the two organisations, and to support the sharing of best practice on areas such as regulatory policies and procedures.

The Director General of SGA, Camilla Rosenberg said that: “This is an important agreement for us. We have common interest in many areas. By opening the communication channels between the authorities we become stronger in our supervisory activities. This is the beginning of a broad and long-term cooperation. Earlier this year we have entered a MoU with Malta Gaming Authority and Gibraltar Gambling Division.”

Neil McArthur, Chief Executive of the Gambling Commission said: “We have excellent relations with other gambling regulators from across the world and our new link up with the Swedish Gambling Authority will give more opportunities to share good practice on a whole host of regulatory issues, cooperate closely and take shared action where appropriate. We look forward to working with colleagues in Sweden over the coming months and years.”

The MoU came into force as of the 11th of November 2019.
